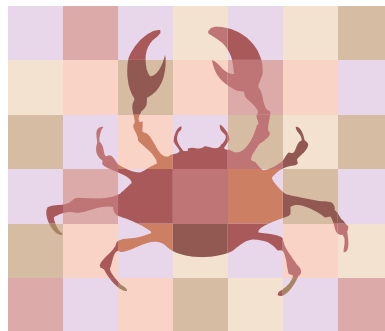

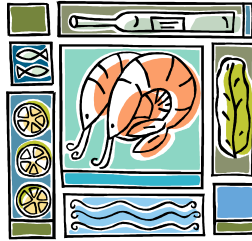
With more yet to confirm ~there will also be activities for the children, including face painting. The RNLI will be mounting “Get yer Kit on” races and Dummy Rescues on the River

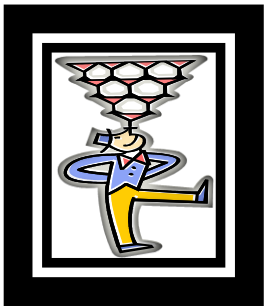
